This Course Is Designed To Give All Shooters Regardless Of Background The Solid Foundation And Knowledge Required To Consistently And Safely Engage Targets At Extended Distances With A Precision Rifle. Through Consistency, Repetition And Proper Mindset The Student Will Be Taught How To Select The Proper Equipment For His Mission Or Preferred Shooting Activity, How To Setup That Equipment, And Eventually How To Configure It So He Can Use His Rifle At Long Range Targets. The Course Will Also Cover The Fundamentals Of Marksmanship As It Relates To Long Range Shooting, The Environmental Factors That Affect External Ballistics, The Use Of Ballistic Computers, And Wind Formulas. All Courses Are Provided By Licensed Instructors With Law Enforcement Or Military Experience And Employed By Homestead Training Center. *Be Advised That This Course Will Be Shot From The Prone Position, Not From A Seated Bench Rest Position. Additionally, This Course Is Limited To Calibers Of .300 Win Mag And Below. Please Refer To The Required Equipment Items For This Course At The End Of This Curriculum.*

NOTE: Due To The Nature Of This Shooting Discipline (PRECISION SHOOTING), This Is NOT A High Round Count Course, However There Is A Lot Of Technical Information That Is Required To Be Covered In The Course, So Bring Pen And Paper.

- Eye/Ear Protection
- Small Rear Stock Bag (Preferably A Bag That Can Be Easily Molded, Not A Hard Bag)
- Bi-Pod Or Bag To Support Front Of The Rifle
- Shooting Mat
- Chamber Flag(You May Purchase Flag In Office If You Do Not Have One)
- Notepad & Pen
- Ballistic Computer
- Kestrel Weather Meter(If You Use One)
- Logbook(If You Use One)
- Any Spare Part Or Tools You Think You May Use Or Need For Your Scope Or Rifle
- Batteries For Any Electronics Used
