This Course Is Designed To Increase The Skill Complexity And Technical Ability Demanded Of The Student While Using A Precision Rifle. The Course Is Centered Around Shooting From Alternate Positions Using Different Obstacles And Support Tools. Unlike The Basic Course, Which Was Shot Entirely From The Prone Position, This Course Will Be Shot From A Number Of Different Positions. Students Will Be Introduced To Specific Techniques For Effectively Shooting A Scoped Precision Rifle From The More Traditional Kneeling And Standing Positions. However They Will Also Be Required To Problem Solve And Think Unconventionally On How To Use Their Available Gear To Ultimately Achieve A Solid Shooting Platform From Complex And Unstable Obstacles. Students Will Also Be Shown Ways To Use Their Gear To Achieve The Most Solid Shooting Platform To Effectively Engage Targets Out To Distances Of 500 Yards. Additionally Students Will Be Taught The Mathematical Formulas And The Information Needed To Range A Specific Target And Effectively Engage It. Throughout The Course All Students Will Be Expected To Maintain A Standard Level Of Accuracy And A Standard Time Frame For Engaging Specific Targets. This Course Is A Must In The Progression Of A Shooters Development. If As A Shooter You Ever Plan On Using This System In Any Practical Capacity Whether For Hunting, Competing Or If You're A LEO Or Military, This Course Will Help You Get A Better Understanding Of What It Takes To Employ This System In A Less Than Perfect Environment. *Be Advised That This Course Will Be Shot From The Prone Position, Not From A Seated Bench Rest Position. Additionally, This Course Is Limited To Calibers Of .300 Win Mag And Below. Please Refer To The Required Equipment Items For This Course At The End Of This Curriculum.*

NOTE: Due To The Nature Of This Shooting Discipline (PRECISION SHOOTING), This Is NOT A High Round Count Course, However There Is A Lot Of Technical Information That Is Required To Be Covered In The Course, So Bring Pen And Paper. Be Advised That This Course Will Be Shot From All Kinds Of Unorthodox Shooting Positions. Please Ensure That You Can Get In And Out Of These Position, Kneeling And Seated Positions NOT From A Seated Bench Rest Position. Students Should Be Able To Get In And Out Of Those Positions With Little Or No Trouble.

- Chamber Flag (You May Purchase Flag In Office If You Do Not Have One)
- Notepad & Pen
- Ballistic Computer
- Kestrel Weather Meter (If You Use One)
- Logbook (If You Use One)
- Any Spare Part Or Tools You Think You May Use Or Need For Your Scope Or Rifle
- Batteries For Any Electronics Used
