INTERMEDIATE PRECISION RIFLE

This course is designed to increase the skill complexity and technical ability demanded of the student while using a precision rifle. The course is centered around shooting from alternate positions using different obstacles and support tools. Unlike the Basic Course, which was shot entirely from the prone positions, the course will be shot from a number of different positions. Students will be introduced to specific techniques for effectively shooting a scoped precision rifle from the more traditional kneeling and standing positions, however they will also be required to problem solve and think unconventionally on how to use their available gear to ultimately achieve a solid shooting platform from complex and unstable obstacles. Additionally students will be taught the mathematical formulas needed to range a specific target and effectively engage it. Throughout the course all students will be expected to maintain a standard of time and accuracy while engaging targets. If as a shooter you ever plan on using the precision rifle in a practical capacity this course will help you get a better understanding of what it takes to employ this system in a less than perfect environment. This course is a must in the progression of a shooter's development.

This course is limited to calibers of .300 Win Mag and below.

Be advised that this course will be shot from unorthodox positions. Please ensure that you can get in and out of these positions with little or no help

****REQUIREMENTS: BASIC PRECISION RIFLE OR INSTRUCTOR APPROVAL****

- Small Rear Stock Bag (Preferably A Bag That Can Be Easily Molded, Not A Hard Bag)
- Bi-Pod Or Bag To Support Front Of The Rifle
- Shooting Mat
- Chamber Flag (You May Purchase Flag In Office If You Do Not Have One)
- Notepad & Pen
- Ballistic Computer
- Kestrel Weather Meter (If You Use One)
- Logbook (If You Use One)
- Any Spare Part Or Tools You Think You May Use Or Need For Your Scope Or Rifle
- Batteries For Any Electronics Used
